RE: Non-Media Related Information on the Coronavirus

In our efforts of maintaining your training goals to improve your current and future financial situation, we wish to provide you with some further information on current events.

Due to the recent concerns surrounding the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) we've done our own research and wanted to put your mind at ease with regards to attending our school.

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (or CDC - click [HERE](#)) has been reporting on the virus since its first discovery in Wuhan, China, in December 2019. As an example, the California Department of Public Health (or CDPH - click [HERE](#)) reported on their website that as of March 13th, 2020 there have ONLY been 5 deaths associated with the Coronavirus (COVID-19) across the ENTIRE State of California; taking into account the state's population was reported by the U.S. Census Bureau at 39,512,223 MILLION people as of July 2019 (see MAP attachment [HERE](#)).
